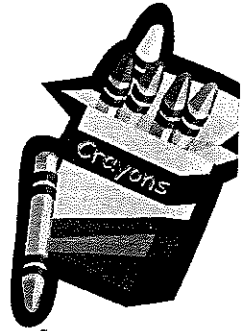
Nebinger Elementary School Kindergarten Readiness Check List

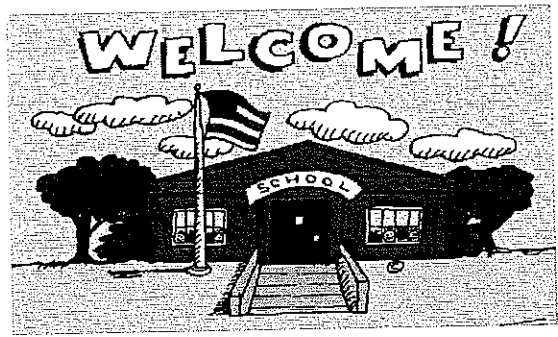

Dear third grade parents,

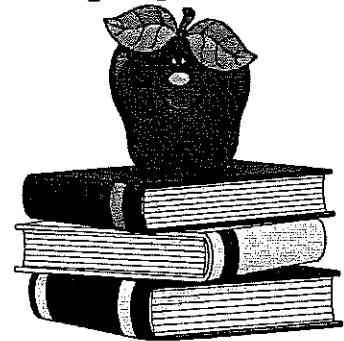
Welcome to the beginning of a fantastic school year! This year your child's teachers will be partner teaching! We would like to take this opportunity to introduce ourselves.
